WHEREAS, Midland Township, Michigan, is a political subdivision within the State of Michigan with an official Emergency Operations plan in compliance with Section 19 of the Emergency Management Act, Act 390, Public Acts of 1976, as amended.

WHEREAS, Midland Township, sustained severe losses of major proportions brought on by the flood resulting in the following conditions: damages to roads.

WHEREAS, the Township Board certifies that the Midland County Emergency Operations Plan was implemented at the onset of the disaster on June 23, 2017 at 9:00 am, and all applicable disaster relief forces identified therein were exhausted.

WHEREAS, as a direct result of the disaster, public damage and expenditures were extraordinary and place an unreasonably great financial burden on Midland Township totaling up to \$100,000.
