ORDINANCE NO. 104

An ordinance to amend the Midland Township Zoning Ordinance, Midland County, Michigan.

The Township of Midland, Midland County, Michigan, ordains, pursuant to the authority vested in it by Act 359 of 1947 and Act 184 of 1943 of the Public Act of the State of Michigan, as amended:

SECTION 1.

Chapter 3, General Requirements, Section 305, Accessory Buildings, is hereby amended to include the following:

6. **Storage Containers.** In a residential zoning district, no building nor structure initially constructed or designed for use as a mobile home, mobile office, shipping container, recreational vehicle, other vehicle or parts of vehicles including trucks, buses, truck cabs, truck boxes and semi-trailers shall be used as an accessory building or for storage.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall become effective eight (8) days after publication thereof.
